- /// Engaging in long-term joint ventures with Aboriginal owned and operated businesses to add real and meaningful value to each other's growth and development.
- /// Ensuring that we maintain the cultural integrity of all our Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander engagement initiatives.

- /// Are designed to formally engage with Traditional Owner Groups at the commencement of projects.
